Come volunteer on the Lower Rock Creek Trail!

The BLM Bishop Field Office and Inyo National Forest, in partnership with Friends of the Inyo, Fat Bike Mammoth and the International Mountain Bike Association, will host a morning of trail maintenance on the Lower Rock Creek Trail in celebration of National Public Lands Day. Meet at the lower parking area (at the former Paradise Lodge) at 830 AM for bagels and coffee. Trail work will start at 9 AM and continue until 1:00 or so. Volunteers will cut back brush, clear tread, maintain wooden bridges and remove trash from along the stream. Please wear hiking shoes or boots, long pants and long sleeve shirts. Water and snacks will be provided; refillable water bottles are encouraged. Parking in the area is limited, please carpool if possible.
